

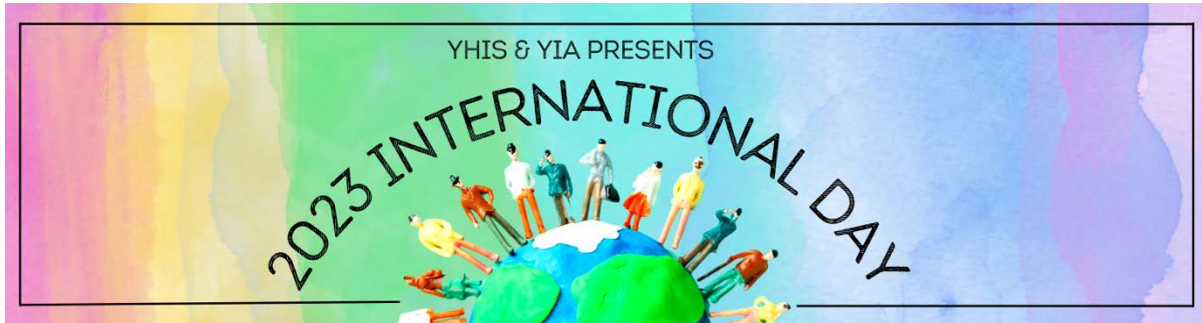

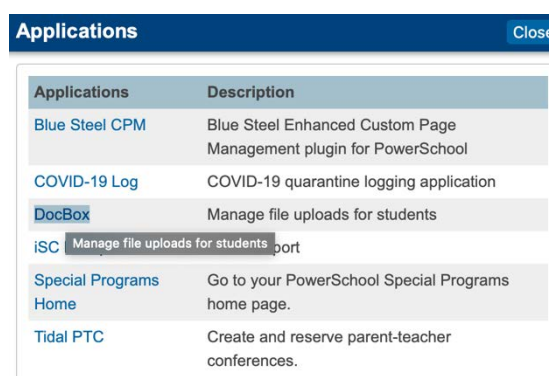
## FALL MAP GROWTH TEST REPORT

Parents of students from Kindergarten through 6th can access their child's MAP report through PowerSchool from 4:30 pm on Tuesday, October 10. Once you log into PowerSchool, click the "Applications" icon in the top right corner and then click "DocBox" on the list.

Parents can refer to the MAP Data Parent Guide ([LINK](#)) on how to read the report. These MAP Growth tests not only determine the student's instructional level, but also measure their academic growth throughout the school year (and from year to year) in various subjects. Please note that MAP Growth scores are just one data point that teachers use to determine how a student is performing. Please discuss any questions that you have about your child's performance with your child's teacher.
