School and community

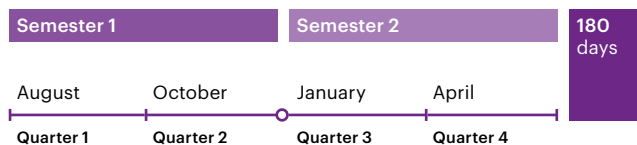
Yantai Huasheng International School (YHIS) is an independent, American-based curriculum, college-preparatory school serving expatriate students from age 3 through grade 12 in Yantai, China. Founded in 2016, YHIS is the first English language international school licensed by the Shandong Provincial Government in Yantai. The school enrollment has increased from 121 in 2016 to 272 in 2023. Since expatriates come at different times in the year, admissions happen on a rolling basis.

Curriculum

- American-based curriculum that follows the AERO standards.
- 17 Advanced Placement (AP) courses
- English only instruction with limited/no language support.
- Students have the opportunity to pursue independent studies and internships
- Curriculum undergoes a review every five years through LifePlus's system of schools.

School calendar

The school year generally starts at the end of August and ends in the middle of June. It is divided into two semesters of two quarters each. There are a minimum of 180 days in the school calendar.



Graduation and credit requirements

24 credits are required for graduation, with one credit earned for each full year of passing work in a course in grade 9–12. Specific credit requirements include the following:

Grading + GPA

For students in grades 11–12 in the 2023–2024 school year: Honors courses will earn an additional 0.33 grade points, AP courses will earn an additional 0.66 grade points. Additional grade points will not be given for students entering grade nine 9–10 in the 2023–2024 school year.

Due to the transient nature of our student body and the diversity of educational backgrounds, Yantai Huasheng International School does not report class rankings.

Yantai Huasheng International School holds accreditation for grades Pre-K through 12 with Cognia.

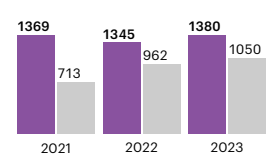

3 Year SAT® Summary

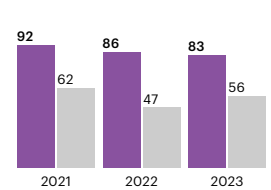

Dual enrollment

Yantai Huasheng International School now offers Dual Enrollment college-level courses through Grand Canyon University, a Higher Learning Commission approved institution. Dual Enrollment courses enable eligible students to simultaneously earn university and high school credit. Courses are completed within a seven-to-fifteen-week time frame and add additional academic rigor to a student's profile.
