LifePlus requires all students and parents to complete this booklet and return it by Friday, August 16. We would greatly appreciate your assistance in signing the booklet and sending it to your child's homeroom or advisory teacher.

ATTENDANCE POLICY

Parents should send an email to <u>attendance@yhischina.com</u> by 8:00 *am* on the day their child will be unable to attend school. The specific reason for the absence should also be given at this time.

Students should not be sent to school if they have:

- 1. Severe colds
- 2. Fever (above 99.86°F/37.7°C)
- 3. Nausea or vomiting
- 4. Diarrhea
- 5. Undetermined rash or spots
- 6. Lice

Parents should not give medicine in the morning to reduce fever, and then send their child to school.

If a student is sent home with fever, diarrhea, or vomiting, the student may not return to school the next day.

Students may return to school:

- Nasal discharge or phlegm is clear
- No fever for 24 hours (no medication to reduce fever for 24 hours)
- Has not vomited or had diarrhea for 24 hours

STUDENT RESIDENCE PERMIT APPLICATION

LUNCH FEE TOP-UP THROUGH POWERSCHOOL
