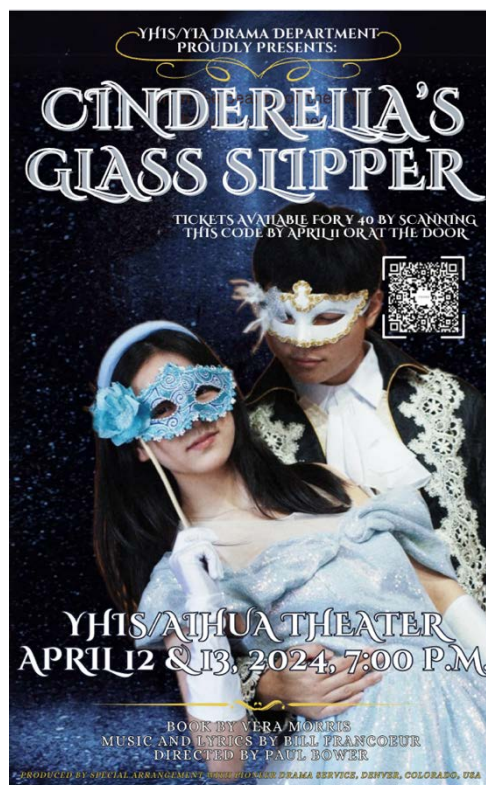
Cinderella's Glass Slipper
