Requirements for Office:

Candidates must have been YHIS parents for at least one year in the past and commit to at least one additional year in the future, starting from the beginning of their term.

Terms of Office:

Officers are elected for a single academic year and may serve a maximum of two consecutive terms in the same position.

Election Process:

While all positions are voluntary, in the event of multiple candidates for a single role, a ballot vote will be conducted. should there be no candidates for a particular position, the Head Principal will review recommendations and make appointments accordingly. Applications and voting will be facilitated online for convenience and accessibility. The deadline for applications is Friday, May 3, and voting will occur on Wednesday, May 8.

To assist parents in re-enrolling, we will set up two computers in room 107, and our admissions staff will be available to provide assistance on Monday and Tuesday, April 29 and 30.

MAP® Testing

As part of the LifePlus network of schools, YHIS is conducting the Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) tests as a form of standardized testing from Monday, April 29 – Friday, May 24. The MAP test is for students from Kindergarten to 10th Grade. Students will be tested in the fall, winter



students from Kindergarten to 10th Grade. Students will be tested in the fall, winter, and spring of each school year. The test will be administered on school computers or iPads.

MAP tests determine your child's instructional level and measure academic growth, both throughout the school year and from year to year, in the areas of Math, Language, Reading, and Science. MAP tests are unique in that they are adaptive tests. That means that the test becomes more difficult with the more questions your child answers correctly. When your child incorrectly answers a question, the test becomes easier. Therefore, your child will take a test specifically catered to his or her learning level.

Since MAP Growth tests provide immediate and accurate information about your child's learning, teachers use this information to identify students with similar scores that are generally ready for instruction in similar skills and topics. They then plan their instruction accordingly so that students learn optimally.

There is no additional studying that students need to put in for this test. Rather, the test serves as an assessment tool for where a student's levels are currently. The school is excited to focus on your child's individual growth and achievement.

High School Student Council Elections

The Student Council elections for the 2024-2025 school year are coming up.

Student Council applications will be given to all interested students in advisories. Students are also welcome to pick up applications from Ms. Forstrom's office (424) any time before the application due date. Applicants for President and Vice President must be current 10th or 11th graders who have at least one year of StuCo experience, while applicants for the other officer positions must be current 9th—11th graders with no previous experience necessary. Current 8th graders may apply for an assistant position if they have previous experience in Middle School StuCo.

All applications are due to Ms. Forstrom's office by April 30 at 17:00. Applications submitted after this date will not be accepted. All applicants will be interviewed by Student Council advisors to ensure that they meet the qualifications for their desired position(s). These interviews will be conducted from May 2 – May 8. When all interviews are completed, students will be notified whether or not they have been approved for the ballot. Students may then begin their campaigns as soon as they have been notified of their approval.

As part of the campaign process, candidates for President and Vice President will have the opportunity to address the student body on May 16. The elections for President and Vice President will take place directly after the speeches, and secondary students will have the opportunity to participate in the voting process during lunch on those days. The speeches/elections for other officer positions will take place on May 23.

A grade representative from each grade will be elected in the fall. However, students interested in being a grade representative should still fill out the application this spring, as the application process and the interviews will all take place in May. The grade representative election will take place shortly after school resumes in August.


PSAT 8, 9, 10 Results
