Each student has received or will receive a hard copy of the yearbook.

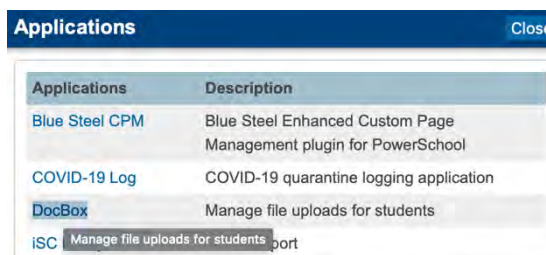
### Spring MAP Growth Test Report

Parents of students who took Spring MAP testing can access their child's MAP report through PowerSchool from Monday, June 3. Once you log into PowerSchool, click the "Applications" icon in the top right corner and then click "DocBox" on the list.

Parents can refer to the MAP Data Parent Guide ([LINK](#)) on how to read the report. These MAP Growth tests not only determine the student's instructional level, but also measure their academic growth throughout the school year (and from year to year) in various subjects. Please note that MAP Growth scores are just one data point that teachers use to determine how a student is performing. Please discuss any questions that you have about your child's performance with your child's teacher.

## HSK Testing on June 22

The registration for the June 22 test opens at 4:00 pm on Monday, June 3, and ends at 4:00 pm on Wednesday, June 12. Taking the HSK test is open to anyone. You can register and make your payment through the official HSK website. After a successful registration, you will receive a confirmation email. As soon as the capacity (30 per session) is reached, the registration will end. The HSK tests will be administered on school computers.
