### **Library Announcement**


As the school year draws to a close, we would like to inform you of important dates regarding library usage:

We are aware that some of our parents drop their child(ren) off at the north gate daily and are concerned about their safety, particularly during heavy morning traffic in front of the school. To address this, the school blocks the entire front area indicated by the red rectangle for parents to safely drop off their child(ren) from 7:40 to 8:30 every day. The designated drop-off area is indicated by the purple rectangle. The expected car movement



is indicated by the blue line for your reference. During this designated time, parking is prohibited in the front area. After 8:30, the drop-off area can be used for parking as before.

## **ECC & Elementary Summer Camp**

Summer is here once again, and as always, we are excited to announce the ECC & Elementary Summer Camp. The ECC camp is open to Foundations and Jr. Kindergarten students, while the Elementary camp is open to Kindergarten through Fourth-grade students. The camp will start on Tuesday, July 23, and will run on weekdays only until Thursday, August 1. Our foreign and national staff will lead the camp.

The summer camp fee is 3,000 RMB for the first child, 2,000 RMB for the second child, and 1,000 RMB for the third child. This cost includes both busing and lunch at the school cafeteria. *Please note that there will be no refunds even if you do not utilize the school bus or lunch service.* A typical summer camp day will run from 9:00 am to 3:00 pm.
