Medical Report for Students Entering G1, G6, and G9

All new/returning students entering grade 1, 6, and 9 for the new school year are required to complete a Student Medical Report (SMR) and submit it by the first week of the new school year. If a student was new in Kindergarten, 5th or 8th grade, and completed the form upon admission, he/she will not be required to have another exam the following year. The school nurses will give a printed copy to the students entering grade 1, 6, and 9 before the school year ends.

Summer is here once again, and as always, we are excited to announce the ECC & Elementary Summer Camp.
