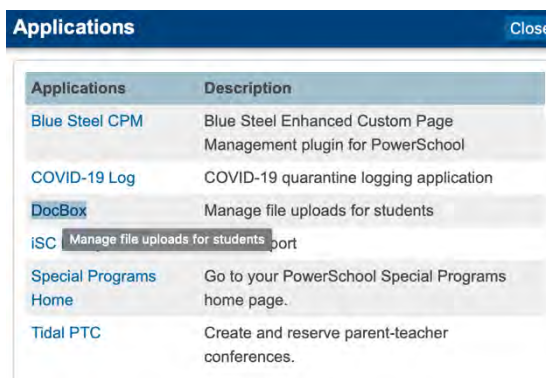
Spring MAP Growth Test Report

Parents of students who took Spring MAP testing can access their child’s MAP report through PowerSchool from Monday, June 3. Once you log into PowerSchool, click the “Applications” icon in the top right corner and then click “DocBox” on the list.

Parents can refer to the MAP Data Parent Guide ([LINK](#)) on how to read the report. These MAP Growth tests not only determine the student’s instructional level, but also measure their academic growth throughout the school year (and from year to year) in various subjects. Please note that MAP Growth scores are just one data point that teachers use to determine how a student is performing. Please discuss any questions that you have about your child’s performance with your child’s teacher.

HSK Testing on June 22

The registration for the June 22 test opens at 4:00 pm on Monday, June 3, and ends at 4:00 pm on Wednesday, June 12. Taking the HSK test is open to anyone. You can register and make your payment through the official HSK website. After a successful registration, you will receive a confirmation email. As soon as the capacity (30 per session) is reached, the registration will end. The HSK tests will be administered on school computers.

Medical Report for Students Entering G1, G6, and G9

All new/returning students entering grade 1, 6, and 9 for the new school year are required to complete a Student Medical Report (SMR) and submit it by the first week of the new school year. If a student was new in Kindergarten, 5th or 8th grade, and completed the form upon admission, he/she will not be required to have another exam the following year. The school nurses will give a printed copy to the students entering grade 1, 6, and 9 before the school year ends.

ECC & Elementary Summer Camp

Summer is here once again, and as always, we are excited to announce the ECC & Elementary Summer Camp. The ECC camp is open to Foundations and Jr. Kindergarten students, while the Elementary camp is open to Kindergarten through Fourth-grade students. The camp will start on Tuesday, July 23, and will run on weekdays only until Thursday, August 1. Our foreign and national staff will lead the camp.

The summer camp fee is 3,000 RMB for the first child, 2,000 RMB for the second child, and 1,000 RMB for the third child. This cost includes both busing and lunch at the school cafeteria. *Please note that there will be no refunds even if you do not utilize the school bus or lunch service.* A typical summer camp day will run from 9:00 am to 3:00 pm.
