

Morning Drop-off Area

We are aware that some of our parents drop their child(ren) off at the north gate daily and are concerned about their safety, particularly during heavy morning traffic in front of the school. To address this, the school will block the entire front area indicated by the red rectangle for parents to safely drop off their child(red) from 7:40 to 8:30 every day. The designated drop-off area is indicated by the purple rectangle. The expected car movement



is indicated by the blue line for your reference. During this designated time, parking is prohibited in the front area. After 8:30, the drop-off area can be used for parking as before.

Fun Boat Race


